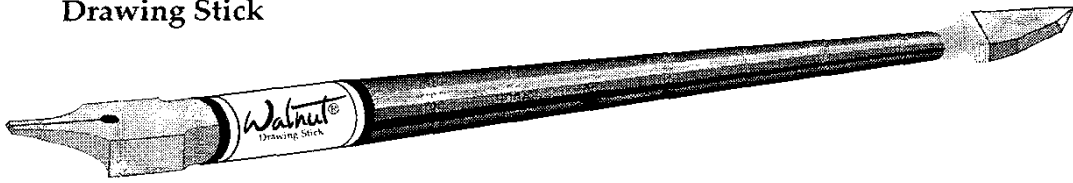

Drawing Stick



Here is a new drawing tool that you may have always wanted. For pen & ink wash drawings - a pen and a brush in one . The fine chisel nib of the pen is carved of bamboo - Its hand dipped ink reservoir will supply about a 36" line of ink. And the felt brush is shaped for a variety of stroke widths. So without changing tools you can achieve the fluidity of a wash the boldness of an expressive mark, or the calligraphic crispness of a drawing pen. Originally produced for use with Walnut[®] Drawing Ink by Tom Norton Designs.

Since my earliest years of drawing, frustrated by having to constantly change tools in mid thought, I learned to tape a steel pen nib to the other end of the best watercolor brush I could afford at the time. It's an old technique - artists have been doing it for years - but it's an expensive one. The Walnut[®] Drawing Stick is a contemporary solution, at an affordable price. -- Tom Norton
